


► State teams now have the ability to download **all data they** have ever submitted to the AIM Data Center.

Downloading Bulk Exports



Why download bulk exports?

Access complete datasets for analysis, compliance, and record-keeping.

Ensure you have a local copy before access ends.



How long does it take to download?

Less than 10 minutes.



How long will exports be available?

Until October 31, 2025.



Do I need a secure repository?

Follow your Data Use Agreement (DUA) requirements.

Using & Sharing Bulk Exports



What can I do with bulk exports?

Create insights – Build charts, graphs, and dashboards to explore trends.

Centralize & secure – Store data in one location for compliance, auditing, and historical tracking.



Can I share this data with hospitals?

Review your Data Use Agreement (DUA) first.

Coordinate directly with hospital teams before sharing.

In addition to bulk exports, you can download ADC File Formatting Templates

These templates include:

- A **data dictionary** for the variables or headers in the bulk export
- A crosswalk mapping variable names to their corresponding measures
- Available on the AIM Resources Webpage.


To launch the AIM Developed REDCap Projects, AIM hosted a AIM REDCap learning sprint. Sessions included:
